- Legal framework to be in place



#### DOCUMENT HOLDERS

- refers to utilization, access control, privacy, selective information sharing
- optional for the document owner

### **ISSUERS**

- refers to standardized utilization, management and fines / restrictions control, reduced costs and risk of reproduction, better assistant in lost / stolen DI
- produce revenue with mainly single investment

### **VERIFIERS**

- refers to process reliability, reduced privacy-violation risks, better QC by eliminating the human factor during issuing
- reduce identity frauds and risk of use expired / invalid DL

#### CHALLENGES

- Lack of verifiable security feature
- No harmonization of display, barcodes not interoperable
- Carrier's liability with Doc Check
- Checking website > Not supported
- Time-sensitive Check-In Process
- No automation or digitalization of Doc Check possible
